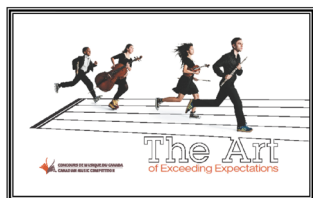

The Canadian Music Competition (CMC) is a national non-profit organization dedicated to discovering, supporting and promoting promising young Canadian classical music students. Founded in 1958, the CMC currently has 17 chapters, including the Oakville-Mississauga chapter.

Through its work, the organization encourages musicians to surpass themselves, cultivate discipline and perseverance, sharpen their critical skills, develop their artistic personality and grow both personally and professionally. Founded in 1958 in Montreal, the CMC has grown to 16 chapters across Canada. The same spirit that drove the founders is still alive today in all the volunteers who are committed to the goals of the organization.

To meet its objectives, the CMC established three different programs: the Canadian Music Competition itself, the Junior Program and the Stepping Stone. These programs allow performers an opportunity to share their talent and learn in the company of their peers while gaining experience in performance. It also provides the public the chance to discover and encourage young developing musicians and emerging professionals.
